Mr. Martin,

I neglected to include a topographic representation of the Koppers site in my correspondence with you yesterday. Although I am sure you have much more sophisticated information to work from, the rough topo illustrates the general direction of runoff from the eastern half of the site onto the CSX right-of-way all along the boundary.

I would also like to include another comment:

6. Runoff from the highly contaminated north lagoon area should be prevented from going directly into the ditch. Therefore, the berm alongside the western side of the ditch should be extended sufficiently southward to ensure runoff capture from that area. Please see additional attachment.
