Status of Field Events

- **First Semi-Annual Groundwater Sampling Event for 2016**

Groundwater samples were collected from the Floridan well CFW-1 during the month of June in accordance with the proposed monitoring program (Gradient memorandum, dated March 11, 2016).

Data Inventory

A list of the groundwater samples collected during the month of June as part of the first semi-annual sampling event in 2016 is summarized in the table below. Analytical results for these samples have been reviewed and submitted as part of the semi-annual report.
