Data Inventory

No additional data were collected during the month of September.

Data Reporting

The 100% Remedial Design (RD) Report for the Hawthorn Group Remedy was submitted to US EPA and other stakeholders on September 14, 2018. US EPA approved the 100% RD Report, with the exception of the Operations, Maintenance, and Monitoring Plan, in a letter dated September 21.

Upcoming Action Items

US EPA is considering input from stakeholders prior to approving the Operations, Maintenance, and Monitoring Plan associated with the 100% Remedial Design Report. Meanwhile, Cabot has initiated the process to procure construction services for remedial action implementation at the Site.

The routine annual groundwater monitoring event at the Site is scheduled for the week of November 5 to 9, 2018.
