Cabot Portion of Cabot/Koppers Superfund Site, Gainesville, FL**

Data Inventory

No samples were collected from the site during the month of January.

Data Reporting

Cabot submitted the 2016 Annual Groundwater Monitoring Report for the Cabot portion of the Cabot Carbon/Koppers Superfund Site on January 5th. On January 31st, Cabot submitted the revised Supplemental Remedial Investigation/Focused Feasibility Study (SRI/FFS) report to US EPA and other stakeholders.

Upcoming Action Items

Cabot will be conducting paired indoor air and soil gas sampling at the Former Winn Dixie building to assess the potential for subsurface vapor intrusion into the building. This work is planned for the week of February 6, 2017.

Cabot will begin remedial design upon approval of the SRI/FFS report by US EPA.
