Upcoming Action Items

The first semi-annual monitoring report for 2017 will be submitted in June 2017.

Cabot received US EPA approval of the Supplemental Remedial Investigation (SRI)/ Focused Feasibility Study (SRI/FFS), and has started the process for procurement of the services of an engineering firm to assist with detailed remedial design and implementation of the remedy for the Cabot Carbon Site. Cabot requested and received a 60-day extension from US EPA for drafting a Remedial Design Work Plan and Surficial Aquifer Remedy Optimization Work Plan; these documents will be submitted on or about August 10, 2017.
