Subject: Proposed addition to the *Upper Floridan Aquifer Interim Remedial Measure Work Plan*
for the Cabot Carbon/Koppers Superfund Site, Gainesville, Florida

Dear Mr. Miller:

Thank you for your email of July 20, 2009, approving the proposed Upper Floridan Aquifer Interim Remedial Measure (IRM) (December 28, 2008 Work Plan, as amended by the GeoTrans letter of May 1, 2009).

Given the recent groundwater concentration results at FW-22B, Beazer believes it would also be prudent to initiate pumping at that well in order to contain constituents near the northwestern property boundary. Beazer proposes to convert that monitoring well to a pumping well as part of the IRM, with a removable plug below the third (from top) screen. The WestBay sampling apparatus will be removed prior to installing the pump and the installation and monitoring procedures will be the same as those described for FW-21B.

Please let us know if adding FW-22B to the IRM will be acceptable to the Agency.
