



U. S. Environmental Protection Agency Announces Local Group Submits Letter of Intent for the Cabot Koppers Superfund Site

The U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has received a letter of intent to apply for a Technical Assistance Grant (TAG) from the Protect Gainesville's Citizens, Inc. The grant will be used to help concerned and interested community members understand and interpret technical information developed during the Superfund environmental investigation and anticipated cleanup of the Cabot Koppers Superfund Site located in Gainesville, Florida.

The Superfund law allows for issuance of only one grant of up to \$50,000 per site to a single citizens' group for sites listed on the National Priorities List (NPL), a list of hazardous waste sites eligible for attention under the Federal Superfund cleanup program. The grant is provided to enable communities near an NPL site to hire a technical advisor to interpret EPA documents and assist in providing input to EPA on cleanup actions. In order to ensure that all community views are represented in the recipient group, EPA encourages all groups interested in applying for this grant to coalesce and file one application. Within 30 days from the date of this notice, groups that wish to coalesce with the Protect Gainesville's Citizens, Inc., for the purpose of this grant application must notify the following:

Groups wishing to submit a separate grant application must submit a letter of intent (LOI) to EPA within 30 days of the date of this notice. All groups will then have an additional 30 days to file applications. If only one group submits a LOI, that group may submit a grant application 30 days from the date of this notice.

All applications must be submitted within 60 days of the date of this notice. Groups that require additional time to prepare a LOI, or to file an application, may submit a timely written request for an extension to EPA for consideration.
