Kelsey , Rick and Scott,

ACEPD is reviewing the workplan for Tar removal in the creek and will have comments in the next week or two . Preliminarily we have identified the following issues that need to be addressed. There may be others and these will need coordination with the FDEP, Water Management District and the City of Gainesville.

Our preliminary issues are

1. Permission to remove material/fill on private property and easements (if they exist).  
The creek bed is private property in most cases.
2. Permits needed for removal and placement of materials (FDEP, WMD and/or COE).
3. Schedule, December is likely too optimistic for obtaining permits (April and May are also dry months)
4. Turbidity, pollutant and sediment controls; continued turbidity/pollutant monitoring.
5. Pump around or berms in the creek.
6. Use of an ATV in the creek.
7. Staging area(s).
8. Fill source and placement.
