GRU has two comments to the work plan:

- 1. We question the proposed sequence for adding materials assembling sample reactors. The stated sequence starts by placing soil in the vessel, then adding concentrated oxidant from a stock solution, and then adding site groundwater. We wonder about the reaction of the concentrated oxidant with the soil before dilution by the groundwater. See Section 3.2 Background Non-Target Oxidant Demand Tests for example.
- 2. We expect the delivery of oxidants to the COCs in situ in the Hawthorn Group at this site to be a challenge and ozone especially so.

Neil will send you any comments he may have early next week.
