Thank you for your follow up. I have spoken with the EPA project manager who confirmed that it is reasonable to expect that either Beazer or Cabot would install and maintain the warning signs on the DOT ROW. Most likely Cabot. If that is the case, Cabot would enter into an MOU with DOT, if necessary. EPA will discuss with the Cabot project manager when he (Cabot PM) is back from vacation the week of the 23<sup>rd</sup>. Cabot and their consultant will be in Gainesville in August/September for the vapor monitoring event and would conceivably be able to install the last 2 signs at that time. I'll let you know if we hit a roadblock.
