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Fred- DEP Tallahassee has not received a work plan for bldg demolition at Koppers. I spoke with Ashwin Patel in RCRA who said a DEP permit or bldg demolition plan would not be required under RCRA unless they were demo'ing a treatment bldg ( like a drip track pad). DEP District RCRA is reviewing a Tank demolition plan. Ashwin also checked with the DEP District Air folks who indicated that they have not received any type of air monitoring work plan or a bldg demo plan. If so, the demolition plan has not been submitted to the local government or the Health Department for their review and comments. In addition, the demolition plan should including information how dust/ air borne issues will be monitored or reduced during the demolition phase. I cannot support a demoliition permit being issued until these issues are discussed or the demolition plan submitted.
