Hi, John- I am still out of the office this week and responding remotely from home. Things are going pretty well although I am pretty "tired" and dealing with some side effects of treatment...

I will be happy to discuss Creek signage further with ya'll. You had previously provided a map with recommended sign locations along the creek which we discussed in a followup conference call. Subsequently, I indicated to you that the signs could be placed on public property including City/County owned property but that if private residences declined to allow posting of signs on their properties along creek, we would not post signs there. Warning letters will also be going out- goal being by 7/23 - to those property owners along creek where sediments exceed allowable concentrations for unrestricted use (residential SCTLs). Those warning letters will be sent to owners of property where samples were collected along with adjacent property owners where similar concentrations might be anticipated. We anticipate that will include about 45 property owners.

I have signs and overlay stickers in my office and can have them delivered them to you. I think the only issue now is if the City is available to install the signs and how may public access locations there actually are. With that info Stu should be able to decide if his group can install signs.

I don't have the map with proposed creek locations at home with me. But will try and get into office at least briefly to retrieve that and other site related info. I am going to try and come in to office next week for a few days prior to my next treatment on 7/23. Even if I am not in office next week I can read email and schedule a time to talk to you.

I apologize for the inconvenience of all this.
