Madam Mayor,


We, the Stephen Foster Neighborhood Association, refer to the City Commission Special Meeting of March 9, 2009 discussing the future of the Cabot-Koppers Superfund site and its intended clean-up.

Specifically, we write concerning statements made at that meeting by Mr. Robert Pearce. We find it necessary, therefore, to clarify the position of the Stephen Foster Neighborhood on this matter.

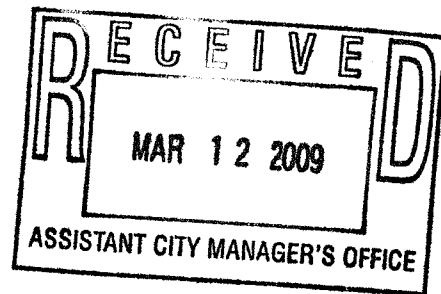
To these ends, we unequivocally state that Mr. Pearce does not speak on behalf of, or for, the Stephen Foster Neighborhood or the Stephen Foster Neighborhood Association, despite his current presidency of that group. Indeed, in our own meeting, the Association unanimously voted that the future land-use and zoning of the Cabot-Koppers Superfund site should be changed to that of "Residential" as recommended by the Commission itself in the prior Public Hearing on this matter.

Indeed, no single officer in our group is permitted to make contrary statements on behalf of our group where voting has taken place. We do not agree, therefore, to the compromise position as personally presented by Mr. Pearce at this most recent meeting about Cabot-Koppers. Thus Mr. Pearce's sentiments should not be misconstrued or misinterpreted as representing the views of our neighborhood at large.
