May 2019 Monthly Progress Report Cabot Portion of Cabot/Koppers Superfund Site, Gainesville, FL

Data Inventory

Environmental Standards performed the semi-annual groundwater sampling event at the Cabot Carbon Site in Gainesville, Florida the week of May 13 through 17, 2019. The scope-of-work included recording groundwater elevations from the site wells and system sumps and collecting groundwater samples from four Upper Hawthorn Group wells (HG-36S, HG-37S, HG-38S, and HG-39S), five Lower Hawthorn Group wells (HG-31D, HG-36D, HG-37D, HG-38D, and HG-39D), and the Floridan Well (CFW-1). No additional samples were collected during the month of May.

Data Reporting

The Cabot remedial interceptor trench discharge pump station monitoring report for the first quarter of 2019 was submitted to Gainesville Regional Utilities (GRU) during the week of April 22. Table 1 shows the volume of groundwater collected and treated during the second quarter.

Note: Daily and monthly discharge volumes are reported to GRU quarterly.

Upcoming Action Items

US EPA approved the Modifications to the 100% Remedial Design report with the exception of the Operations, Maintenance and Monitoring Plan, for which stakeholder input/comment is pending.

Procurement of construction services for remedial action implementation is expected to be completed late June or early July. An updated schedule will be provided in July. At this time, we are still contemplating a late July mobilization.
