Attached are some FDOH dioxin sample results from chicken eggs that were taken in the Stephen Foster neighborhood. We were locally circumvented by this initiative but the results are negative with a very conservative risk estimate. The location of this property is about ¼ mile away from Koppers on NW 36 Avenue.
