Dear Mr. Miller

This E-mail is my official comment on the Cabot Superfund 3rd 5 year review.

From 2001 until 2008 when I learned of the Cabot/Kopper Superfund Site, and that the Hamilton Park Development was built a top it. I often noticed a "funny" smell (and still do) in the area and wondered what and where it was coming from. As the years went by I noticed the smell only along N Main ST. and 23 St.; not in other places in our fair city. On many occasions as I would drive on and around the "SITE" I have become nauseated and had to leave the area. The times when I was "over come by the smell and nausea" it was almost always very hot steamy day, we have plenty of them here in North Central Florida. Often I wondered what could be "baking in the earth over there?" Now I just "NEVER" shop there. This has a economic impact.

I now believe it to be chemicals from the lagoons and share with others in my community, concerns about the lack of true and extensive RI/ and action by PRP and US EPA Region 4 to protect enviornment and human health. In review of some Historical documents it does seems that pryor Project managers and Directors at US EPA Region 4, were informed and some how still failed to act in a protective enough manor.

I also would like to clarify, the TAG mentioned by Mr. Meiburg in his response to Mr. Prager's letter; on behave of Ms. Lisa Jackson; was (I believe) awarded for the "Koppers" portion of the Cabot/Kopper Superfund Site. There were no funds in the budget for review of the "Cabot portion". I believe this would constitute a "Separate Operational Unit".

I would be in support of funding should the Non-profit Protect Gainesville's Citizens or some other qualified group of citizen seek funding for a TA adviser to help better inform the community on the Cabot portion.

This being said instead of farther duplication of concerns, I wish it be on the record that I am in support of the "open letter" by BANCCA.org and their suggestions.
