Dear Mr. Miller:

It has come to our attention that the EPA's Administrative Records Index for the **Cabot Koppers Superfund site (EPA ID: FLD980709356)** is woefully out of date. A quick review of this 17 page type-written index, located on the EPA's website here: <http://www.epa.gov/region4/waste/npl/nplfln/cabot.pdf> ...indicates that this index has not been updated since July, 1993! That was 17 years ago.

It is our understanding that this index is supposed to list all pertinent documents, reports, letters and other correspondence related to this Superfund site, so that the public is made aware of this information, and can request copies of any documents they may be interested in reviewing. It may also be required to fulfill any EPA obligations under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA).

Therefore, we respectfully request that this Administrative Records Index for the Koppers Superfund site be reviewed and updated as soon as possible, and a digital (electronic) copy be made available on your website for use by the general public. We also ask that this index be regularly maintained by your staff.

Updating and maintaining this records index is a vital part of keeping our community informed on past and current issues related to the Koppers Superfund site, and will also help the EPA achieve its goal of "protecting human health and the environment".
