Anthony,

I would like to set up a meeting/conference call between you and or Paul Myers and Randy Merchant, the health risk staff in Tallahassee to discuss the issue of air sampling around the Koppers plant site.

ACEPD received a request from the BOCC to get a cost estimate for doing air sampling around the plant in response to citizen concerns raised at the May 1, 2008 Joint city county Commission meeting with USEPA about excessive dust from the site. The concern appears to be are the neighbors next to the site being exposed to contaminants, Arsenic, Dioxin and PAHs, above levels of health concern from dust migrating from the Koppers site. It is known that the soils on Koppers are contaminated.

It appears from the old files on this site, that the State Health Department performed a health risk assessment for the Cabot Koppers site in 1995. The report dated November 15, 1995 states that "based on air quality data from the site periphery for one week in 1988, there was no apparent risk of cancer or other illness to residents surrounding the site in 1988." Also, "There have been no off-site air quality measurements on the contaminants of concern since 1988."

The only contaminants of concern measured were arsenic and chromium. There was no analysis for organics including dioxin at that time.

ACEPD is trying to come up with a screening level scope of work that will generate enough data that could be used to potential for health concern based on current site conditions since the last time this was checked was 1988. We want to make sure that the design of the study is correct and talk about how the data acquired may be interpreted.

We have gotten a cost estimate from MACTEC one of our local consultants based on some preliminary discussions I have had with them but I am not sure that the design or extent of sampling is sufficient. It is also very expensive.

We do not have funding for this work at this time and it may not be paid for by the County. We may try to get \mbox{EPA} to pay for it.

Before we get too far into this, I would like to have a discussion with yout and Randy Merchant since he was one investigators of the 1995 report and discuss what kind of data is needed and how much data is needed, and how important it is to get this data (and possibly if this monitoring is even needed)

Please give me a call and let me know when we can discuss this and set up a meeting date.
