Hi Kelsey,

We revisited the area of disturbance calculations based on better information regarding the staging area and the access routes (see table below). We found that the total estimated area of disturbance is less than an 1 acre. Although much of the staging area was already in use for other purposes, we included it in the calculation anyway.

If you would like me to contact the DEP NPDES folks and provide them the pollution prevention plan I can do this.

We have filled out the NPDES permit form on line and have it ready to submit in the event something changes that would cause the project to exceed 1 acre of disturbance.
