

LEGAL NOTICE

Beazer East, Inc. ("Beazer"), at the request of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("DEP"), has filed an application for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") permit that will govern the discharge of stormwater from a property that formerly housed an operating industrial plant. Beazer purchased the property located in the City of Gainesville from Koppers Inc. in March 2010. Beazer is not operating the industrial plant currently, will not be operating the plant in the future, and intends to dismantle the remaining plant structures in the final quarter of 2010. In conjunction with Beazer's NPDES permit application, Beazer has been requested by the DEP to publish the following notice:

Any comments or objections should be filed in writing with the Department at this address. Comments or objections should be submitted as soon as possible to ensure that there is adequate time for them to be considered in the Department's decision on the application.
