The US Environmental Protection Agency is conducting a Five-Year Review of the Cabot Carbon/Koppers Superfund site in Gainesville and as part of a five-year review, EPA is interviewing the community regarding the site. L'Tonya Spencer, the Community Involvement Coordinator for EPA, will be conducting community interviews in Gainesville on November 3rd and 4th and will be available to interview Alachua County Commissioners who would like to participate.
