Attached is the submittal we received from Beazer's consultant. The current permit does include reference to the potential for on-site irrigation and requires review by DEP prior to commencing on-site irrigation with this type of treated water.

This is Beazer's plan to use treated groundwater, extracted from the Site Floridan-Aquifer pumping wells, as a source for irrigation and dust-control water on Site. This plan will help conserve use of GRU drinking water and will reduce discharge of clean water to the GRU wastewater system.

I received a call from Robin Hallbourg at ACEPD last week who asked about an outstanding permit that would authorize Beazer to use treated water from the onsite Floridan Aquifer recovery system for dust control and watering of grass to further prevent erosion and airborne dust. Is that water use a part of the current stormwater permit or other outstanding permit application at DEP that you know of? Beazer's contractor thinks that there is an outstanding permit or some other documented permission without which they cannot use the water for irrigation purposes.
